Annual Report Summary of the Institution by IQAC.
Session 2022–2023.

In the academic session of 2022-2023, 1123 students were admitted to the college. 975 students appeared for the final year University examination in all programmes during this in this session. The results of which are expected in the coming months. Our students have participated in sports activities and cultural events within the college as well as intercollege competitions. They also participated in State and National level competitions organised by various institutes and organisations and have performed well and won prizes and certificates in several events.

West Bengal Youth Parliament competition was held in August, 2022. Selected students represented Prafulla Chandra College in the event.

The college arranged several awareness camps for student's credit cards and the college also observed a student's week in January 2023.

The College participated in NIRF, 2023 in this session and also submitted required information to AISHE. AQAR 2021-2022 was also submitted on time.

Coming to the performance of our faculty, we would like to share the following:

- Dr. Aindrila Biswas, Assistant Professor of Commerce successfully participated in Interdisciplinary Refresher Course on Research Methodology from 16.6.2023 to 30.6.23.
- Prof. Debarpita Banerjee, SACT teacher of Department of Geography was awarded Ph. D on December 15th, 2022.
- Nine faculty members have ten research papers published in peer reviewed and UGC cared journals and twelve papers published in edited Volumes. Four members of the faculty were invited to deliver talks by external organisations.
- Seven members of the faculty have received academic grant from the college for paper publication and presentation at national and international level Seminars and Conferences.

- Eight Add-On courses were conducted by various departments and an Add On course was conducted on Yoga Training as part of Life Skill Development Programme during the current academic session.
