# Prafulla Chandra College Annual Report Summary of the Institution by IQAC. Session 2023–2024.

In the academic session of 2023-2024, 1075 students were admitted to the college. 953 students appeared for the final year University examination in all programmes during this in this session. The results of which are expected in the coming months. Our students have participated in sports activities and cultural events within the college as well as intercollege competitions.
